2017 Bred and Owned Program Eligibility Requirements

4-H & FFA Market Livestock Show and Sale

All exhibitors interested in participating in the Bred and Owned program will be required to provide the following information for their Bred and Owned animals. This is a two part requirement process. Please note deadlines for both. All components and parts will need to be submitted complete and on time to be eligible for the program.

Bred & Owned Definition: The immediate family must own the dam at time of service and conception. The exhibitor must have continuously cared for the market animal since birth.

Part 1: Due at Initial Weigh-In**

- Sire and dam farm identification
 (Options include registration number, tag number, brand, or flock of origin number).
- Date of Birth
- Flock of origin number for sheep and goats only

All exhibitors will receive a form for this information with their initial weigh-in notification letter which will arrive approximately two weeks prior to weigh-in. <u>Each</u> animal will be required to have the information items listed above.

**Initial weigh-in for Steers – February 11th

**Initial weigh-in for Lambs, Goats and Hogs – June 3rd

Part 2: Due July 14th to the Extension Office
